Case Study

Capstone Farm, Medway Council

Medway Council's vision was for this play area to become a flagship play space for Medway, providing a variety of play opportunities for both toddlers and juniors. They wanted a unified play area that took inspiration from the natural landscape and history of the park and that encouraged a sensory play experience and incorporated existing changes in landform as a play feature.

Capstone Park is a site of historic importance and is one of Medway Council's biggest countryside parks, so the design needed to be in keeping with the sensitivity of the site. With this mind, we replaced the 2 old units with one of our UniPlay multi-play structures that would perfectly sit on a slope, providing an additional play feature. As well as being packed with various play activities, this UniPlay also features a DDA ramp, making it fully accessible and inclusive for children of different abilities.

A smaller multi-play unit and seating were also installed to cater for children of all ages and provide a resting point for everyone. The design, colours and materials chosen on all the play equipment flawlessly complements the beautiful leafy surroundings.

The Head of Regeneration at Medway Council commented: "Capstone Farm Country Park is one of Medway's seven Green Flag parks. Thousands of people visit the park each year and we are delighted to have installed new play equipment and surfacing graphics for children to enjoy.
