## **Case Study**

## Municipal Gardens, Rushmoor Council

Rushmoor Borough Council were looking to transform their existing playground by making it a destination style play area that catered for children of all ages. It was also important that the play space was inclusive and accessible to as many people as possible.

The requirements from Rushmoor Borough Council were to provide play equipment that was engaging and challenging for a mixed age range and different abilities, emphasising on younger children, up to age of 12. During consultations with the community, they highlighted the importance of having fully accessible provisions.

We removed the existing play equipment and surfacing and installed new play equipment that was stimulating, challenging and accessible. The fully accessible and inclusive multi-play structure installed on a slope, provides the 'wow' factor that attracts local residents to the playground. It features a wheelchair accessible ramp with plenty of activities that everyone can enjoy.

As well as providing children with an abundance of exciting and inclusive play equipment, seating facilities were also installed so that parents, carers and children of all abilities can rest in proximity to one another and get a chance to socialise.

The play area was designed with DDA regulations and wheelchair access in mind so that all members of the community were able to visit the play area easily and comfortably.
