With an emphasis on quality, a large multi-level play unit with various platform heights, ramps and a double width slide as well as a great playhouse is a central focus of this playground.

A swing area contains a brilliant variety of accessible swings, including the full-support Mirage seat, a Tango face-to-face swing seat and a ever-popular basket seat.

Something for everyone

A fantastic PlayCube provides an eye-catching multifunctional play piece, which children love to climb but can also hide away inside, whereas a rotatable Cosy Cocoon allows children to chill out and experience a relaxing slow spinning sensation.

With a sensory path lined and a line of brightly coloured musical instruments, this playground really inspires and encourages everyone to play together.


