Project Background

The redevelopment of the old Battle Hospital site saw S106 contribution towards improving the play facilities at nearby Portman Road. This was split between a Children's Playground and a Multi-Use-Games-Area.

The Council received four submissions for this project, all met the initial criteria and were shortlisted.
